

## Terms & Conditions of „Warsaw Explorers’ Club” Project

Warsaw Tourism Organization’s (WTO) project: „Warsaw Explorers’ Club” is meant to promote Warsaw’s museums and cultural institutions and encourage frequent visits in such among tourists and locals („Project”).

The playfully competitive format of collecting stamps is aimed at maintaining engagement, building a habit of participating in the cultural offer as well as striving for individual or collective (school groups) achievement.

An incentive to take part in the project will be a certificate and prizes sponsored by Warsaw Tourism Organization and/or participating museums.

WTO is the organizer of the Project.

## Verification rules

### How to certify a visit at a museum?

A proof of visiting a museum is a stamp, which should be placed in a designated place of the collector’s booklet.

All museums participating in the project have a dedicated page in the booklet, with a description of the collections/exhibitions in Polish and English. A designated space for collecting the stamps can be found on the final pages.

A museum stamp to be used will be displayed by the museum in a designated place, e.g. in the gift shop, at the reception, in the cloakroom or near the exit from the institution.

## Operating principles of the Project

1. „Warsaw Explorers’ Club” is meant for everyone who wishes to get to know Warsaw’s museums/cultural institutions more in depth and at the same time explore the capital’s complex and fascinating history and its unique atmosphere.
2. The aim of the Project is to promote Warsaw’s museums, their exhibitions and collections, as well as expand its tourist potential among different age groups through an engaging format of collecting stamps.
3. Participating in the Project is initiated through a purchase of the **Warsaw Explorer’s Club** booklet. Booklets will be available in the chosen participating museums, at Warsaw Tourism Organization’s office at Podwale 13 in Warsaw or at a Tourist Information Point in the Palace of Culture and Science.
4. Persons of under 18 years of age are exempt from the requirement to collect a stamp from the Museum of Polish Vodka in order to receive a final prize.
5. The price of the booklet is 15 PLN.

6. A stamp will be received after a visit in each of the museums taking part in the Project, collected from a designated place.
7. After collecting all of the stamps a scan or a photo of the last two pages of the booklet needs to be sent to [office@wot.waw.pl](mailto:office@wot.waw.pl) for verification.
8. After reporting the completion of the project WTO will reconfirm it by granting a **Warsaw Explorer's Certificate/Diploma** to the participant.
9. For the first three participants to collect all stamps the organizers have provided the following prizes:

**1st place award** – an overnight stay with dinner at a historical Warsaw hotel

**2nd place award** – a package of vouchers to the capital's key tourist attractions

**3rd place award** – a personalised tour of the city

Additionally: sets of promotional gadgets/souvenirs

Information about a giveaway of extra prizes by WTO will be published each month on <https://www.OdkryjWarszawe.pl> in the **Warsaw Explorers' Club** tab in the news section.

10. Extra prizes are surprise souvenirs provided by WTO and/or participating Museums.
11. An extra prize will be given to the first person to find the relevant information about such prize in Warsaw Explorers' Club tab, published on 5th of each month, and inform about it via e-mail to [office@wot.waw.pl](mailto:office@wot.waw.pl)
12. Prizes can be collected in person from WTO office located at Podwale 13 in Warsaw or will be posted to the address specified by the Winner.
13. The booklet's price of 15 PLN includes: proceedings of Warsaw Tourism Organization, proceedings of the participating museums and a donation to „Daj Herbatę” Foundation which for many years has been helping people affected by homelessness.
